

CubingUSA Teams Policy

Dec 6, 2017

Version 1.0

- The Board of Directors ("Board") may create and appoint individuals to one (1) or more teams ("Teams"), each consisting of one (1) or more directors, non-directors, or a combination of directors and non-directors. The Board may, at any time, remove any member of the Team or revoke or modify any or all of the responsibilities assigned to the Team.
- The Board must specify the mandate of a Team at the time of its creation. Teams may only act in accordance with their mandate, and as directed by the Executive Director.
- The Board may, at its discretion, grant responsibility for management of a Team to an Officer.
- The Board of Directors may, at its discretion, grant the Executive Director alone or the Executive Director and any Officer authority to appoint or remove members of a specific Team.
 - All staffing appointments (including renewals) and removals must be reported immediately to the Board of Directors.
 - If an Officer is granted such authority, the Executive Director may overrule their decisions.
 - If the Executive Director is granted such authority, a vote by the Board as per bylaws may overrule their decisions.
- Term of appointment to a Team may not exceed 18 months unless otherwise decided by the Board of Directors.

Supported Competitions special case:

- Organizers and volunteer staff for CubingUSA Supported Competitions are covered under the CubingUSA Supported Competitions Policy instead of this Teams Policy.
